Charles Williams composed music for many movies and TV programs. A Quiet Stroll was used in the BBC TV program “Farming”.

The original score appears not to be available from any source (at this time) so the arrangement was made “by ear”. Hopefully it has enough notes in common with the original...

The arrangement is suitable for quintet or larger ensemble. There are a few notes on glockenspiel/bells, but they also appear in the first voice so this part can be omitted.
